MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS



DEFINITIONS

- "C2CD" means Cheek2Cheek Dance.
- "Member" means the person(s) named who have been accepted for membership of Cheek2Cheek Dance.
- "Venue" means any current teaching/event venue as detailed on the Cheek2Cheek Dance website (www.Cheek2CheekDance.co.uk).
- "C2CD events" means all tea dances, formals, balls and dance trips
- "Tuition" means classes, practice sessions, technique workshops, private lessons and any other form of dance tuition.
- Terms in the singular include the plural, and vice versa.

Membership

- Adult Members must be age 18 years or over.
- According to the type of membership applied for, the Member will be subject to all rights and obligations attached to that membership.
- Membership cannot be transferred, loaned or given to third parties.
- On acceptance of any application for Membership, Members agree to be bound by these terms and conditions as the same may be changed, added to, varied from time to time and will be notified to members.
- Use of the membership allowance for C2CD events and tuition will be recorded on each Member's Attendance Card, which must be presented on booking an event or at the start of a tuition session.
- Priority booking for C2CD events and tuition does not guarantee places at those activities.
- Access to the Venue and use of the facilities at the Venue for C2CD events and tuition is solely at the discretion of C2CD and Members may be restricted from such access or asked to leave the Venue at C2CD's discretion.
- All Members must wear appropriate clothing for C2CD events and tuition.

Fees, Charges, Cancellations and Refunds

- Membership is for a period of 12 months and does not renew automatically.
- The membership fees are non-refundable unless cancelled within 14 days of first purchase and no facilities have been used.
- Membership fees payable for C2CD events and tuition are non-refundable once allocated to Members, whether attended by Members or not.
- C2CD reserve the right to refund any portion of the membership fees in exceptional circumstances at its sole discretion – a £50 administration charge will be payable on all refunds.
- Membership fees will be collected monthly in advance on the first of each month by direct debit, during the period for which the Member has agreed to become a Member.
- Cash, BACS or PayPal may be requested as an alternative method of payment if the primary payment method fails.
- Membership fees may be increased at C2CD's discretion; any such increase will be notified to Members in advance and Members will have a period of at least one month before such increased membership fees will apply.
- Private lesson cancellations must be received 1 week in advance otherwise there is a cancellation fee of £15 – this fee will be collected by cash, BACS or PayPal after notification to Members.

- Additional C2CD events and tuition may be purchased at the standard rate. Specifically, additional C2CD classes and private lessons may be purchased at the 'pay in advance' rate on a weekly or one-off basis, within the duration of the Membership.

Membership Duration, Cancellation and Extension

- Membership is for a period of 12 months.
- Fees automatically continue during the 12-month membership period subject to giving a minimum of 1 month's written notice to cancel the membership; such notice must be sent by email to C2CD. An email response will be provided to Members as confirmation of such cancellation.
- Such 1 month's notice takes effect on the first day of the month following receipt of the notice, and membership will terminate at the end of the last day of such month.
- C2CD has the right to continue to collect any membership fees, where invalid cancellation has been provided, not in accordance with the procedures outlined above; such as cancelling direct debit instructions with a Member's bank but without notice to C2CD.
- If a Member is incapacitated due to illness or injury for more than 2 calendar months and cannot attend classes or private lessons during that period, then Membership will be extended at the discretion of C2CD. Initial notice must be given via evidence of a doctor's appointment or hospital visit. Membership will be extended for the number of full calendar months the member is incapacitated minus 1 month.
- Any remaining outstanding payments due may be passed to a debt-collecting agent.

Facilities and services

- C2CD reserves the right to close all or any part of the Venue where necessary at its discretion, during C2CD events and tuition.
- Wherever possible, changes to class timetables will be notified at least 2 weeks before the changes take effect, to private lessons at least 1 week before, unless said changes are due to illness, bereavement or other such circumstances beyond C2CD control.

Venue Usage

- Members use the Venue at their own risk. Staff, agents, and subcontractors of C2CD are not medically qualified.
- Members who are unwell should not attend the Venue and may be denied access if suffering or considered to be suffering from any infection or contagious illness, at C2CD's discretion.

Limitation of Liability

- C2CD accepts no liability for any loss, damage, or theft of any personal items belonging to Members that are brought into the Venue.
- C2CD also accept no liability for any death, personal injury or illness occurring at the Venue, including that caused by equipment at the Venue, or for any such matter occurring following a visit to the Venue, but this shall not exclude any statutory liability C2CD may have and Members' statutory rights are not affected.
- Members are fully responsible for ensuring that any facilities or the usage of any equipment at the Venue is operated in the correct manner. If Members are unsure of any of these, they should consult any member of C2CD's staff at the Venue.
- Some areas of the Venue will not be supervised at all times and C2CD does not accept any responsibility for harm or injury, unless caused by any staff or subcontractor's negligence or error.

Conduct

- Members must not abuse the facilities, equipment or dance floors at the Venue, and must respect other Member's privacy and property at all times.

- Any damage wilfully or negligently caused by Members must be paid for by the Member.

Termination by C2CD

- C2CD may terminate a membership if Members do not follow any of the terms and conditions above.
- C2CD may terminate a membership and press charges if a Member abuses (verbally or physically) any member of staff or another member of C2CD.
- Termination will occur with immediate effect and no refunds will be available if there is a breach of these terms and conditions given they include appropriate conduct and more.
- C2CD reserves the right to cancel a membership if there is a breach of conduct.

Miscellaneous

- C2CD reserve all rights for any press or any promotional materials in relation to C2CD, or for C2CD events and tuition which take place at the Venue.
- Members are only permitted to use any cameras (including cameras on mobile telephones) or other filming equipment at the Venue with the express permission of C2CD. Permission must be obtained from C2CD for any filming or recording of C2CD events and tuition taking place at the Venue.
- C2CD and Alison Dean will own all copyright in any film, recording or photography taken at the Venue, for which prior permission has not been obtained.
- These terms and conditions may be changed, added to or varied by C2CD at any time and such changes/additions/variations will be notified to Members and apply once put on display on the website.
- These terms and conditions are subject to any additional notices displayed at the Venue, whether for Health and Safety requirements, or otherwise.

N.B.

- You confirm that the information provided by you is correct in all respects and you will notify us promptly if any of this changes.
- This information will be kept on our systems to enable better administration of C2CD and our classes.
- It will also be used to add you to the C2CD mailing list, keeping you informed of events, classes and other information that we think may be of interest to you.
- We will not pass your details to any third parties unless compelled by law to do so.
